

Greetings-

Our 2021-22 academic year is winding down, and we are left with the memories of our 2022 Commencement Ceremony and our MPTC Year End Celebration. A sincere thank you to all who helped make both events successful.

As reported at the Year End Celebration, on June 15 the Moraine Park District Board will vote on holding a referendum this fall. Earlier this spring, the Capital Expansion Visioning Project (CEV) team worked on a long-term facility plan to increase our student success and community impact. A survey was mailed to approximately 10,000 homes in our district, and the results were compiled and used to make a formal recommendation to the board.

Results of the survey showed a referendum at \$55 million dollars was favorable in having voter support. This proposal includes projects in Fond du Lac, Washington and Dodge counties; the survey also included a Green Lake County project, but the results for the Green Lake project reflected less support from our district.

It is ultimately the District Board's decision to move forward with the proposed referendum. Next week, a board retreat will be held as a final chance to share logistics and more about each of the proposed projects.

This is an exciting time for the College as we consider moving forward and embrace ways to adapt and grow for our students and communities. We will plan to reconnect after the June Board meeting with the results of their decision. As always, District Board meetings are open to the public.
