Behavioral Rules and Discipline

- Not allowed to touch any lab equipment unless otherwise instructed.
- Not to bully or cause harm to other participants.
- Expected to follow the directions of all Moraine Park leaders.
- Not allowed to use any offensive language.
- To follow the same dress code as required by their school.
- To remain in their classroom/lab under the supervision of the Activity Leader.

Students who are misbehaving will receive two verbal warnings. If their behavior is not corrected, they will be escorted out of the classroom and their parent/guardian will be contacted.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Tornado Warning

Students will be escorted to a marked shelter area.

Fire Alarm

 Students will be escorted to the nearest exit, at least 30 feet from the building until an all-clear announcement is made.
