

DUAL CREDIT & HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Dual Credit is the term used for courses for which students are concurrently enrolled and receiving credits. This document will explain the process for requesting Disability Accommodations for Dual Credit and Start College Now Courses at Moraine Park Technical College.

DUAL CREDIT: COURSES TAUGHT BY A HIGH SCHOOL TEACHER AT A HIGH SCHOOL

Accommodation Process: Accommodations will be determined and carried out by the high school special education staff. Moraine Park Technical College Accessibility Specialists are available to discuss typical post-secondary accommodations with high school staff and students. Non-typical post-secondary accommodations include: Modified curriculum, Modified grading, Notes for all tests, Retaking exams, Extended time on assignments, Modified Assignments, and 1:1 aides in the classroom.

START COLLEGE NOW: COURSES TAUGHT BY A TECHNICAL COLLEGE INSTRUCTOR

Accommodation Process: The high school student needs to work with a Moraine Park Technical College Accessibility Specialist to request accommodations. Accommodations will be determined by the Accessibility Specialist at Moraine Park Technical College. The student can make a request and include required information in Accommodate at:

Please make the accommodation request as soon as possible. Disability Resources may not be able to make an immediate accommodation decision and provide accommodations for students who wait until the course begins or until the day of a test. Accommodations are not retroactive.
